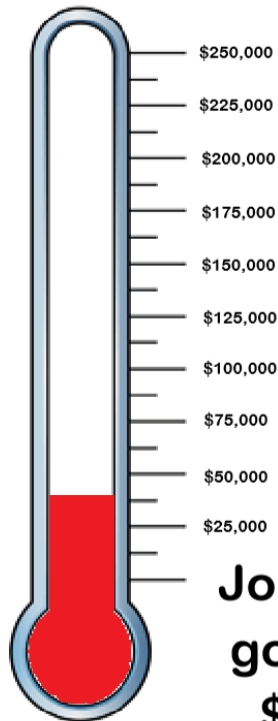

We have not settled on a final design, but current thoughts include multiple living spaces so that we can have room for year round staff as well as have a separate smaller apartment for long term volunteers.

At Camrec we are in a landscape of ongoing change and development! We hope to continue growing programs and facilities that can meet the needs of the church and communities engaged and connected here. We see the experience of camp as an opportunity to invest in the future of Anabaptism, as

well as the Kingdom of God, through children and adults!
